



American Girl Doll Camp



THE CITY OF BETTENDORF REQUIRES THIS FORM BE SIGNED BEFORE PARTICIPATION IN A CITY SPONSORED ACTIVITY. IF THIS FORM IS NOT SIGNED, YOU OR YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE. IT IS A WAIVER OF RIGHTS. **DO NOT SIGN IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS. If you are signing on behalf of a minor, both parents must sign. In the case of a single parent home, the custodial parent must sign. If you are registering your child for class electronically, completion of the registration will be considered your consent and agreement with this document.**

1. You, for yourself and as appropriate on behalf of your child hereby agree to release, waive, and hold harmless the City of Bettendorf, the Bettendorf Community School District, agents, employees, volunteers, and contractors of either entity (Collectively referred to as "RELEASEES") from any and all liability arising from participation in the following activity:

The undersigned further agrees to defend and hold harmless releases, their respective officers, employees, or agents against any claim, cause, loss, cost, or damage whatsoever, including attorney fees, that arises from the above-described activity.
