Family Museum Reindeer Day Performance - 1 & 2:30pm performances

Saturday December 6: 11:45am, arrive at the Family Museum for our Reindeer Day Performance. Dressing rooms will be in the preschool rooms. Hair & make-up should be done before arriving. There will be a warm up in the studios starting at 12:00pm. Performance times are 1pm and 2:30pm. Dancers will be admitted to the Museum for free. Families, if you would like to attend just the performance, we have arranged for free entrance to the Museum for you. Please let the front desk know you are an FMDC family there to watch the performance. If you plan to stay between performances, or your family would like to participate in any other activities at the museum that day, please pay admission or show your membership card. Dancers, if you would like to walk around the Museum between performances, please take off your costume. Dancers are dismissed after our second performance. Take your costumes home with you after the performance. Reindeer Day is also a Pack the Police car event! Between 12pm and 2pm, please bring an unwrapped toy to donate to families in need. The donation site will be located between the Family Museum and the Library.

complete. Parents may sit in the back of the room to watch their dancer perform.
Take your costumes home with you after the performance and return them to the
Museum the following week.





Nutcracker Sweet Costume Information

Peppermint Party Guests

 Red and white dresses with skin-toned tights and skin-toned jazz shoes; hair in low bun parted in the middle or on the side with peppermint hairpiece pinned to sign side of bun

Peanut Brittle Brigade

- Mice gray mice costumes with gray leggings, skin-toned tights, and black jazz shoes; hair worn in a high bun with mouse headpiece pinned to hair
- Soldiers soldier unitard including spats, gauntlets, and hat with skin-toned jazz shoes; hair should be worn in a very low bun so that hat may fit on head properly

Hot Chocolate:

- Juha tutu with pink tights and clean pink ballet shoes; hair in low bun with rose barrette
- Bug jumpsuit with jacket, black socks & black ballet shoes;

Macarons

 Dress with pink tights and clean pink ballet shoes; hair in low bun with macaron headband pinned to head – macarons on right side

Sugar Plum:

• Tutu with pink tights and clean pink ballet shoes; hair in low bun with tiara

Gingerbread Cookies

 Dress with pink tights and clean pink ballet shoes; hair in low bun with gingerbread clip on right side of bun pinned with additional bobby pins
